Students who wish to enrol in English for Academic Purposes (EAP) will have the specific objective of joining a college or university for further study. The focus of the EAP course is to develop the skills areas in English which will be required to study alongside native speakers in mainstream course areas.

EAP Level 1

EAP 1 will meet English language requirements for colleges and other Registered Training Organisations that are private colleges offering VET (Vocational Training) courses. Students will need to reach a level consistent with 5.5 IELTS.

EAP Level 2

Students entering the EAP course at Level 2 will be seeking a pass of IELTS 6.0+ in order to enter a tertiary (Higher Education) course of their choice.

- Shows you how to write an essay and report which is suitable for university or college in an English-speaking country
